

HOAGLAND: STATEMENT AFFIRMING HIS BELIEF IN THE HOAGLAND-VAN FLANDERN POSTULATE

SEATTLE, WA (MARS) March 8, 2010 – Here is the complete text of the statement made today by Richard C. Hoagland, the director of Enterprise Mission, in which he affirmed his belief in the doctrine called the Hoagland-Van Flandern Postulate, which holds that all of the evidence of life on Mars is probative of the notion that there was life on Mars eons ago but that Mars is a planet devoid of life today:
