


## NEW DISCOVERY - ROSS CURLEY - HUMAN VICTIMS OF SOLAR SYSTEM CATASTROPHE



The calcified remains of three victims of the solar system catastrophe of 9,500 BC (top) – two adults (left and bottom center) and a child (bottom right) – lie exposed on an eroding hillside on Mars in this discovery by MARS' Ross Curley. The catastrophe – believed to be caused when debris elements of the Vela supernova explosion entered our solar system, fracturing Mars and squishing it into an oblate spheroid – is theorized to have led to massive floods on Mars' surface, trapping the ancient Martians in mud and leaving their fossilized remains when the mud receded.
